Problem

The tank was experiencing classic Corrosion Under Insulation caused by water ingress that was sitting on the lagging bands around the tank and soaking through the lagging. The problem was further exacerbated by the elevated temperature of the tank. Problem made still worse by the lining material being highly volatile requiring a Nitrogen shroud before and during any potential welding operations.

Application Method

Application was carried out in accordance with with Belzona Know-How System Leaflet TCC-1.
